

SUNSET BIBLE CAMP HANDBOOK

- 1. Focus on camper's needs, they are First priority
- Demonstrate respect and kindness to every camper
- 3. Display a team player attitude among sponsors and staff
- 4. Seek to exemplify Christ in all you do
- 5. Participate in Church sing, worship, pray
- 6. Stop accidents before they happen
- 7. Report infractions of rules to the Dean
- 8. Don't forget you are at camp to bless the campers

SPONSOR/STAFF CONDUCT

- 1. There is a curfew for male and female sponsors/staff. Having no curfew may lead to temptation between high school and college age sponsors
- 2. Do not be in a secluded place with a camper
- 3. As much as possible keep your hands off campers
- 4. Do not be in a dorm alone with a camper for any length of time ever
- 5. It is best for a sponsor of the same sex to counsel a camper
- 6. If a camper behaves as if he or she is getting too attached to you, let the Dean know and take steps to divert the camper away from you
- 7. If you see a Staff/Sponsor behaving inappropriately, notify Camp Director and or Dean
- 8. Sponsors and staff should never discuss grievances or personal problems with a camper
- 9. If a camper needs to be taken off the campground for any reason an adult of the same sex must take them. The Dean notified.
- 10. If you become aware that a camper has experienced abuse or neglect, report it immediately to the Dean. After investigating the incident notify proper authorities.
- 11. Campers are not allowed to leave at any time (Sonic, Pizza Hut, etc.) during camp sessions or free time
- 12. Dress code modest
- 13. Do not let campers (especially younger) call home until you have spoken to the camper's sponsor. Once they speak to Mom they will not want to stay at camp.

CAMP GUIDELINES

- 1. Take care of the camp and its' property (this is your camp)
- 2. In the event that property is deliberately or accidentally damaged, let the Director know. Camp staff will be able to radio Camp Director if he is not in the vicinity
- 3. Let the Director know if there is any water running toilets, urinals, etc. (we are on wells)
- 4. Let the Camp Staff know if you need cleaning supplies for the dorm
- 5. The vacuum cleaners are commercial grade. Let us know if they are not working as the camp has replacement parts
- 6. No roughhousing or running in the dining hall
- 7. Food, dishes and utensils must remain in the cafeteria or front porch
- 8. Do not bring food, candy etc. into the dorms. It attracts mice and critters
- 9. Second food portions will be offered after first servings are completed
- 10. Leftover food will be put in black refrigerator for staff/sponsors
- 11. All medications shall be turned in and administered by the Nurse
- 12. Only authorized personnel permitted in the cooking area, canteen, and nurse's station
- 13. Visitors are welcome and must sign in
- 14. Visitors are welcome to attend evening worship service, but must leave the campground at the conclusion of the service

CIT'S/SIT'S

- 1. CIT'S (Counselors in Training) will be supervised by the Sponsors of the Church they attend with
- 2. SIT'S (Staff in Training) will be supervised by the Kitchen Staff
- 3. If you have any comments or complaints regarding CIT'S/SIT'S let Dean know so that the complaint or positive comment may be properly addressed
